



# MLC Super Fund Choice of superannuation fund nomination form Plum Super

If you are eligible, and would like your employer to make your superannuation contributions to your Plum Super account you can complete this form instead of the *Australian Taxation Office (ATO) – Standard Choice Form* which you may have received from your employer.

The Fund is a complying superannuation fund and accepts contributions from any employer. This form also provides your employer with additional information, including how to make contributions.

Please speak to your employer to determine whether you are able to choose your own superannuation fund. If you have any questions, please contact us on **1300 55 7586**, between 8am to 7pm AEST (8pm daylight savings time), Monday to Friday.



If you start a new job and you do not advise your employer of your choice of super fund, your employer may pay your contributions to a 'stapled super fund'. This is an existing super account which

is linked, or 'stapled', to you and follows you when you change jobs.

Eligible employees can choose a fund as often as they want but you only have to accept one valid choice in a 12-month period. You must accept a valid choice of fund nomination and commence making contributions to the nominated fund within two months.

If the employee has provided this form as their choice of fund, you do not have to request stapled fund information for the employee and can accept this election.
